

SGT. MARC MUNCY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of Sgt. Marc Muncy – E.O.W. 04/05/1995

\$4000 (\$1000/Year for up to four years) Scholarship, awarded to the child, step-child, or grandchild of a law enforcement officer from Franklin County.

Eligibility Requirements: Must be the child, step-child, or grand child of a law enforcement officer who currently works for or is retired from any law enforcement agency within Franklin County (that falls under the FOP Capital City #9). Applicant must plan to attend a 4-year college or university, a 2-year technical or community college, or an accredited program for their Ohio Peace Officer's Certification. The scholarship is renewable for up to 4-years, providing the winner maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0 and works a minimum of 20 hours of community service each year. Official proof must be provided, as well as proof of fall quarter enrollment by September 1st of each year.

Application Requirements: Applicants must complete the attached application, submit a copy of their current high school transcripts, official copy of most recent grade card and write a 750 word essay on one of two topics – “What it means to have a family member in law enforcement” or “Why I want to pursue a career in law enforcement.” The recipient will be selected based on the content of their essay, high school GPA and amount and type of community service worked throughout high school.

Application Deadline: Deadline for submission is April 5, 2010. The scholarship will be awarded at a dinner on May 5, 2010 and announced in the June FOP newsletter.

NOTE: The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university the recipient plans to attend. The recipient will receive notification of the award in writing and must provide the Auxiliary proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution. The institution will be directly on behalf of the recipient.

Please attach an official high school transcript, along with an official copy of your last grade card and the completed essay.

Applications missing any of these items will NOT be considered.
